

Girl students of various departments of MIT ACSC made this competition successful by participating in large number. Essays were based on the topics like Pathbreaking status of women, Women in today's Era. Essays

depicted various aspects of women power alongwith the challenges faced by women. Prof. Pravin Kharat, Judge of the competition announced the winners.

Under "Sukanya Manch Yes, she can" Blood group and HB check-up camp was organized for MIT ACSC girl students on 6th January, 2017. Program started with the Welcome by Prof. Archana Aher. She explained the objectives and vision behind this Blood group and HB check-up camp. The Blood group and HB check-up camp was inaugurated by Prof. Manasi Atitkar with the felicitation of guest. Girl students of various departments of MIT ACSC got benefited with this camp.

Guest lecture on the topic "Smart blood donation and health awareness programme" under "Sukanya Manch" was organized for girl students of MIT ACSC on 6th January, 2017. Dr. Rajendra Pote is a renowned doctor with 40 years experience in the medical field. He explained advantages of blood donation. He also focused on the diet habits of the modern girls today. He referred to the perfect diet for increasing hemoglobin. He also cleared the doubts of the crowd.

To empower girl students to face the challenges in this down trodden society, it becomes necessary to spread the awareness of self defense. Considering this crucial need, Student Development Cell & Sukanya Manch conducted Certificate Program — "Swayamsidhha: An intercollegiate Self defense Programme" for girl students. Ten days program covered daily sessions. On first day self defense training by trainers by explaining Need & importance of self defense and warm up exercise of girls was taken. On second day Inauguration & Guest lecture was organized. Guest lecture was delivered by Mr. Ravindra Labade on topic "Tricks & techniques of self defense." From third day to ninth day self defense training & practical session were conducted



by self defense trainers where they taught Types of punches, Types of kicks, Types of blocks, Road defense tricks, Self defense tricks at various places, Rescue tricks etc. Clinical checkup for girl students was organized on eighth day. Dr. Vrunda Karyekar made check-up and delivered a session on topic "Girls & their health." Guest lecture was organized on tenth day where Mr. Siddhnath Ghayvat enlightened girl students on topic "Today's woman: Opportunities & challenges." This program helped girl students of various colleges about the common tricks and techniques of self defense. Also made them confident and boost their self realization, it was an attempt in bringing forth their caliber and explore it.
