Dr. Alok Chakrawal, Chief Guest of Workshop discussed about the 5 pillars of NEP- access, equity, quality, affordability, accountability and how NEP- 2020 will radically transform India into a “vibrant knowledge hub”. He highlighted the use of Academic Bank of Credits. He discussed how the National Educational Policy-2020 seeks to introduce and implement a sea of changes across all levels of education in India, including the essential understanding of education in the country

Dr. Anil Mulajkar discussed about multiple entry and exit policy and the job opportunities based on skill-oriented program. He talked on the new structure 5+3+3+4. He told that the widespread scope of vocational education or hands-on learning in the new policy will give rise to multiple hybrid jobs.

Dr. Peeyush Pahade guided all the participants on “Examination & Assessment of Learning in NEP 2020”. He discussed about the redesigning holistic and multidimensional assessment which will reflect the progress of skills and uniqueness of each learner in the cognitive, affective and psychomotor domains. He also added that this type of assessment will include self-assessment, peer assessment and teacher assessment.

Dr. Kinnarry Thakkar briefed about distribution of credits. She explained how to design major, minor and generic credits for any syllabus.

Dr. K. C. Mohite was invited as a chief guest for the valedictory function. He briefed about the research opportunities in NEP 2020.

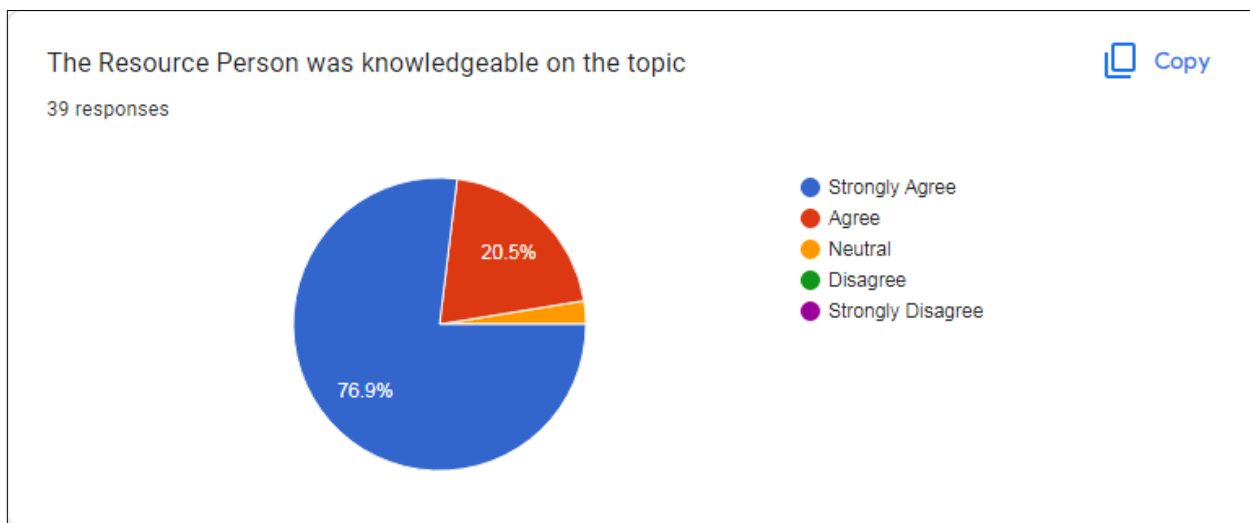
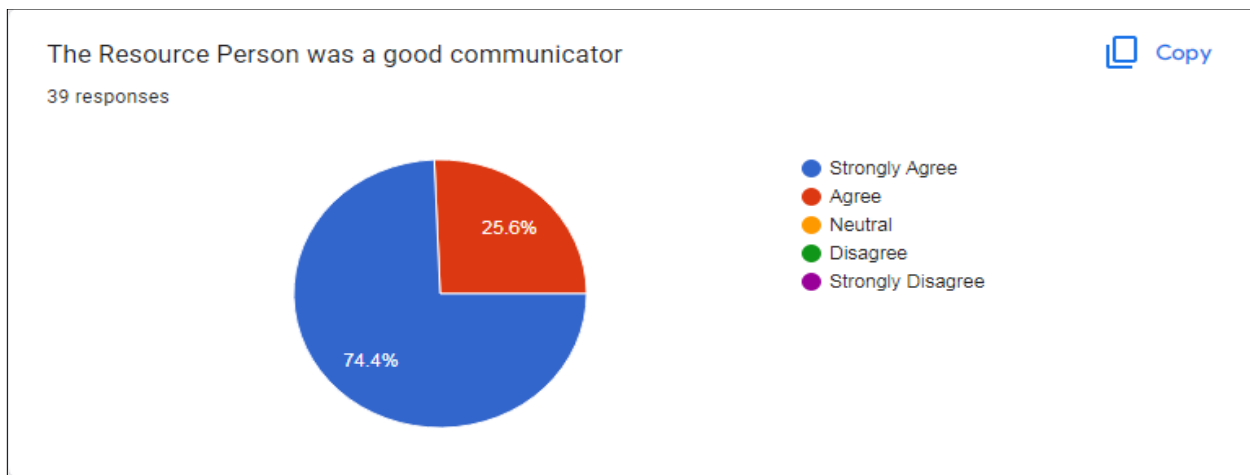
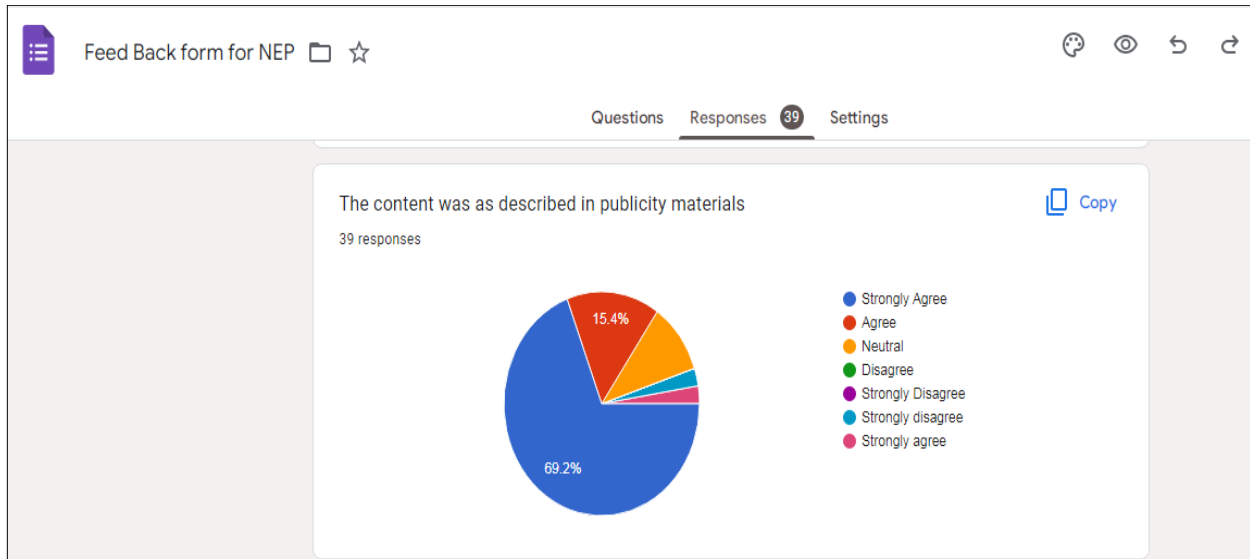




Outcome of the Workshop:

4. Overall, the workshop contributed in creating awareness about the NEP 2020 and generating interest among the participants to take an active role in shaping the future of education in India.

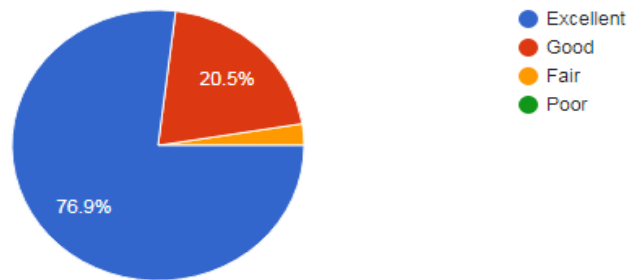
