INDUSTRY VISIT AT BARAMATI

Date: 30/11/2022

MIT Arts, Commerce & Science College, Alandi Pune, Department Business Administration and International Business Organized an Industry Visit to 1) Agricultural Development Trust Baramati 2) Nandan Dairy Pvt Ltd. Baramati 3) Cotton King Pvt Ltd. Baramati on 26th November 2022 under the able guidance of Principal Dr. B.B. Waphare. 144 (86 Boys * 58 Girls) students attended industry visit. The objective behind organizing this visit was to provide the practical exposure to the BBA & BBA-IB students.

Agricultural Development Trust was founded by renowned social reformer Hon. Sharadchandra Pawar and his elder brother Padmashree Dr. D.G. Alias Appasaheb Pawar, in the year 1968 with the objective of serving downtrodden masses and agricultural and educational development among them. The trust is situated at the distance of 5km from Baramati, on the Baramati – Nira Road.

Nandan Dairy Private Limited is a non-govt organization, incorporated on 16th Sep, 1999. It's a Private unlisted company and is classified as company limited by shares. It is involved in manufacturing of pasteurized milk and milk products. Tour started in the morning at 7:00 am in the aim of one day return.



We reached to the destination around 11:00 am, 140km approx. from the college campus. Students were provided with bus facility and were accompanied by the staff members of Business Administration and International Business Department.

Cotton King has a state of art manufacturing unit at High Tech Textile Park in Baramati. Started in the Year 2008, it is the only plant of private garment manufacturer for men that have all production process under one roof. Built across 3 acres of land and currently has capacity of producing about 6000 garments per day.

Our first visit was to Nandan Dairy Private Limited where students understood the process of pasteurizing of milk and other milk products. Thereafter we visited to Cotton King Pvt Ltd. HR. Executives of Cotton King introduced us complete process of fabric making. With ultra-modern manufacturing plant, it ensures that all garments are under one roof – from cutting of fabric to finishing. The administrative heads also co-explained the process of making shirt & trousers. Thereafter we visited to our last destination Agricultural Development Trust to know more about its working and their projects. Mr. Anand Darweshi from Agricultural Development Trust explained in detail about the farms projects and achievement.

The Authorities from all the above industries solved different queries of students & faculties during the visit. Students were amazed to know how the way in which different process works out.

The visit concluded by evening with hi-tea. This study tour was enriching experience for students in getting practical exposure. Students and the staff returned to the college campus around 9:30pm with the enlightenment of a fruitful study tour.
